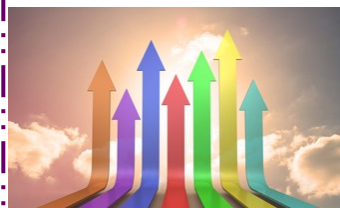
Once we have met with the animators, we will publicise the dates and venues for each of the 6 discernment sessions.
