Readings for the Tenth Sunday in Ordinary Time

READINGS: Genesis 3:9-15; 2 Corinthians 4:13-5:1; Mark 3:20-35

The Book of Genesis tells of the pathetic efforts of Adam and Eve to shift the blame of their sin from themselves on to the serpent, and then on to God Himself. We see the terrible consequences of sin: loss of intimacy with God, and a breakdown between man and woman - the man betrays the woman. However, the sad scene ends with the promise of salvation, a salvation, the GOSPEL tells us, being fulfilled in Jesus. He overthrows Satan and establishes the Kingdom of God.
