### THIRD SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME — YEAR C 27 JANUARY 2019

**READINGS:** Neh 8:2-6,8-10; 1 Cor 12:12-30;  
Luke 1:1-4, 4:14-21

When the Jews returned home after the exile in Babylon, the nation had to be rebuilt. Ezra the scribe had brought with him from Babylon a copy of the Book of the Law of Moses which he solemnly read to the people. Then he called upon them to rededicate themselves to God (**FIRST READING**).



At the beginning of His public life, Jesus reads from the book of Isaiah, making the passage His own, and thus announcing a programme for His ministry (**GOSPEL**). St Paul uses the example of the human body, made up of many parts, to describe the Church. With different gifts, used for the good of the whole Church, we form a unity in Christ.

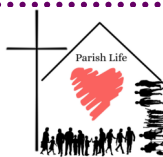

**"I MEAN WHAT DO YOU DO FOR FUN  
OTHER THAN CRITICIZE THE PASTOR?"**

My dear people,

Over the last couple of months Fr Mark De Battista has been travelling the diocese promoting a series of concerts by the world-renowned pianist Eric Genuis. I wish to recommend to you this initiative which will take place in our diocese from 20 February to 20 March 2019.

Eric Genuis is from Simpsonville, Kentucky, USA, and will be touring the Diocese of Wollongong in conjunction with the Centenary Anniversary of St Patrick's Church, Port Kembla. He has visited our diocese before (2009) where he played seventeen concerts primarily in the Macarthur region.

This time he will be playing in parishes and high schools across the four regions of our diocese. Eric brings with him a world class violinist, cellist and soprano and together they perform his music.

In the USA, Eric has performed many concerts in maximum security prisons and in the last two years alone has performed in over forty-five prisons. He firmly believes in the Christian message "I was in prison and you visited me." (Matt 25,37). His impact is amazing! The wardens tell him that for days and weeks after one of his concerts the level of violence in the prison drops markedly.

Eric's concerts are unique because he provides his audience with the source of inspiration so that when the audience listens to each performance, they are drawn into a transforming experience. His music deals with themes such as mercy, faith, forgiveness, love, hope, relationships and so many other ordinary life experiences. Eric's concerts are for all who seek hope and purpose in their lives.

This concert tour is being co-ordinated by Fr De Battista and a faithful team of supporters. I am totally supportive of this project and have been so from its inception. I highly recommend it to you, too, especially in view of the positive and hopeful message it contains. Many parishes have already chosen to host a concert, but there are still some vacancies in the calendar.

This is a rare opportunity to bring a message of hope for our people. Once tickets sales have covered the cost of a concert (118 x \$30 Adult), any additional tickets sold will serve as a fundraiser for your parish.

Towards the end of last year Fr Mark was in discussion with the Office of the Commissioner for Corrective Services NSW to explore the possibility of Eric playing in some of the prisons of our diocese and in Sydney. In early December 2018, Mr Peter Severin gave his permission for Eric to play in the following prisons: Berrima, Nowra, Long Bay and John Morony, Berkshire Park (near Windsor) and Silverwater (women). There could be as many as thirteen concerts in the abovementioned prisons with some having booked the musicians for two days already! Fr Mark is also in conversation with Fr Chris Riley about doing the same for Youth Off The Streets.

This is a great evangelical outreach from our Diocese, and I encourage you to support it in whatever way is possible. ([www.ericgenuistour.com](http://www.ericgenuistour.com) — please see bulletin notice on this page).

I thank you in anticipation as we begin yet another year of pastoral outreach for the Lord in the Diocese of Wollongong.
