Message from Fr Duane

This week, my message is taken from someone far more important than me – Pope Francis himself! He has called us to celebrate October as "Extraordinary Mission Month". It begins with the feast of St Therese (1 October) and reaches its peak on World Mission Sunday (20 October). In his message for this month, Pope Francis writes:

"This missionary mandate touches us personally: I am a mission, always; you are a mission, always; every baptised man and woman is a mission. People in love never stand still: they are drawn out of themselves; they are attracted and attract others in turn; they give themselves to others and build relationships that are life-giving. As far as God's love is concerned, no one is useless or insignificant. Each of us is a mission to the world, for each of us is the fruit of God's love ... To men and women missionaries, and to all those who, by virtue of their baptism, share in any way in the mission of the Church, I send my heartfelt blessing." (Pope Francis: Baptised and Sent - The Church of Christ on Mission in the World).

Each of us shares in God's mission, the mission of the Church, in unique ways. The patron saint of missionaries is St Therese herself – who lived her short adult life in a cloistered convent! But she shows us that love and prayer are the driving force for the mission of the Church. This October, let's prayerfully renew our commitment to our own irreplaceable part in God's mission for the world!

The following prayer is taken from the Catholic Mission website www.catholicmission.org.au:

"Heavenly Father, when your only begotten Son Jesus Christ rose from the dead, he commissioned his followers to 'go and make disciples of all nations' and you remind us that through our Baptism we are made sharers in the mission of the Church. Empower us by the gifts of the Holy Spirit to be courageous and zealous in bearing witness to the Gospel, so that the mission entrusted to the Church, which is still very far from completion, may find new and efficacious expressions that bring life and light to the world. Help us make it possible for all peoples to experience the saving love and mercy of Jesus Christ, who lives and reigns with you in the unity of the Holy Spirit, One God, for ever and ever. Amen."
